### Approval of Minutes

A motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting was made by **Pat Holen**. The motion passed unanimously.

## Officers' Reports

<u>The Treasurer's Report</u> presented by Kathy Boone. The biggest issue currently is the annual trend of Solo & Ensemble going over budget. Currently, before paying the Bellevue College bill, the festival is running roughly \$1,000 short. We have some money-makers, Jazz Band in particular, that can help to offset the cost.

Action Item: The board will prepare and share out data regarding S&E in order to help decide if we ought to raise the cost of participation. Data is mostly referring to number of registrants in past events. Other alternatives include limiting distance traveled by clinicians to lower travel expenses.

### Other Reports

<u>Festival Discussion</u> was truly an open group discussion inviting every member in attendance to contribute to improving festivals in 2018. Members Parker Bixby, Kyle Thompson, Matt Wenman, and Cory Edwards expressed a concern regarding quality of the experience versus the expense to the programs participating. They discussed a continuing trend for schools to only attend the bare minimum in festivals, leaving many schools performing for an empty auditorium. For the same cost, schools and/or the Eastshore region could be hiring some amazing talent to provide very significant and unique educational opportunities.

Patrick Holen and Chandra Rampersad discussed the importance to consider school facilities, schedules, academic conflicts and commitments for students, and many other factors. Through discussion, the group generally agreed that each specialty would be able to propose ways to work around that and to deliver a quality festival in spite of the challenges.

There is an assumption members will bring their groups, so there is little to no pressure to deliver a truly inspiring experience – we are motivated to make it through and hand it off to the next lucky host. If we instead created a festival we ourselves would be really excited to take our groups to, then we are providing an experience worth attending. Systems and incentives that encourage groups to stay all day should be explored so that there is a sufficient audience to provide an authentic performance environment.

**Matt Wenman** proposed that subcommittees meet, one for each ensemble, in order to determine how they would like their festival to look next year, including schedule, clinicians, guest talent, date and time, etc. Parker Bixby was selected to host the band discussion, Matt Wenman to host the orchestra, and Haley Isaacs the choir. The proposal was agreed upon by all in attendance as a suitable course of action. Sub-committees will communicate via email to set a time and location for their meeting sometime before the May general meeting.

#### **Announcements**

There was continued discussion regarding the role of the membership, attendance, and how the board can best meet the needs of everyone involved. We are not seeing an uptick in attendees at our general meetings. Discussion is on-going. Please feel free to get involved by providing your board with feedback or suggestions.
